

Abstract Submission Guidelines

for the

International CTEPH Conference 2021

Please follow the instructions below for your abstract to be eligible for review.

- The content of the abstract must be relevant to the field of Chronic Thromboembolic Pulmonary Hypertension (CTEPH; Nice Group 4)
- The abstract must be written in English
- The text should not be more than 250 words, excluding title, authors and affiliations
- The title of the abstract should be in CAPITAL letters
- For all authors, please provide the family name preceded by the initial(s) as well as the affiliation
- A maximum of 10 authors is allowed
- Please categorise the topic of your abstract as
 1. Basic mechanisms of disease
 2. Epidemiology
 3. Diagnosis
 4. Treatment (surgical, interventional or medical)
 5. Other
- The abstract should be divided into Objective, Methods, Results, Conclusions
- A maximum of one table or figure is allowed
- Any abbreviations used must be explained
- The author submitting the abstract must be a registered delegate at the Conference

The abstract should be submitted as a Word file electronically by email to Sonja Mariotti, ICA secretariat (sonja.mariotti@cteph-association.org). Abstract submission deadline is **01 March 2021**. Abstracts will not be considered for acceptance unless they are submitted according to the format and instructions described above.

All accepted abstracts will be displayed as virtual posters, which may be accompanied by a short presentation (approximately 1 minute) of the content as an audio file. Presenters who participate on site may exhibit a printed poster in addition. The four best abstracts, as selected by the Abstract Review Committee, will be announced during the closing remarks on Saturday, listed on the conference website and marked in the virtual and/or printed poster exhibition.
